

Ordinance No. 3797

An Ordinance closing a utility easement from Atul Sood, on property located approximately one-half mile north of Dearborn Street (41st Street), one-half mile west of 37th Street (209th East Avenue) at 20105 E 36th Place, Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma, (Section 19, T19N, R15E); repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW,
OKLAHOMA:**

SECTION I. The utility easement affecting the real estate described as follows:

See "Exhibit A"

is not presently in use, and is hereby closed. Provided that the City reserves the right to reopen this utility easement in the event it is needed in the future, without the necessity to pay the owner or their successors for the reopening of this utility easement.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
