

ORDINANCE NO. 3444

An Ordinance amending Broken Arrow Code, Chapter 2, Administration, Article II, Purchases, Section 2-25. – When prior approval of Council is required; Granting the City Manager the authority to waive City fees if in the best interest of the City; Repealing all Ordinances to the contrary; And declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW:

SECTION I. That Chapter 2, Administration, Article II, Purchases, Section 2-25, When prior approval of Council is required is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-25. - When prior approval of Council required.

Every contract for or purchases of supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services or waiver of City fees for more than \$25,000.00 shall require the prior approval of the City Council, or of the governing board of the public trust whose funds would support the contract. Contracts for or purchases of supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services or waiver of City fees for \$25,000.00 or less may be made solely by the City Manager or his designee. The City Manager or his designee shall also be authorized to purchase or contract for emergency supplies, materials, equipment, or contractual services which are necessary to maintain operations.

SECTION II. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
