A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE RE-CODIFICATION OF THE BROKEN ARROW CODE OF ORDINANCES; ACKNOWLEDGING THE COMPILATION AND PUBLICATION IN A PRINTED, PERMANENT FORM; NOTIFYING THE PUBLIC OF THE PUBLICATION AND RE-CODIFICATION OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AND THEIR AVAILABILITY IN THE TULSA AND WAGONER COUNTY LAW LIBRARIES AND ON THE CITY'S WEBSITE, AS WELL AS FOR PURCHASE IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO TAKE ALL SUCH ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE COMPLIANCE WITH STATE STATUTE.

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2014, the City of Broken Arrow approved a contract with Municipal Code Corporation for the re-codification of the Broken Arrow Code; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2015, the City received the re-codification and publication of the Broken Arrow Code, which includes the penal ordinances of the City of Broken Arrow; and

WHEREAS, the publication and re-publication are compiled in a permanent volume as required by State Statute; and

WHEREAS, copies of the Code have been provided to the Law Libraries at the Tulsa and Wagoner County Courthouses in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt, the Broken Arrow Code was made available to the general public on the City's website and upon request for a reasonable cost in the Office of the City Clerk, in accordance with applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW THAT the re-codification of the Broken Arrow Code of Ordinances is hereby accepted and approved; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT acknowledgement is hereby made that the Code of Ordinances is compiled in a printed, permanent form as required by the statutes of the State of Oklahoma; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the public is hereby notified of the publication and re-codification of the Code of Ordinances and their availability in the Tulsa and Wagoner County Law Libraries and on the City's website, as well as for purchase in the Office of the City Clerk; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Clerk is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions with regard to this re-codification in accordance with State Statute.
