#### 5. General Board Business

A. 16-395 Presentation of the VoteCast Touchscreen System

Dustin Weber, Network Systems Engineer, Information Technology Department, said the City recently purchase the VoteCast system for meetings. He instructed Board members and staff on how to use the system.

## B. <u>16-394</u> Presentation and possible discussion of Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Sales Tax and Ad Valorem Revenues and Financing

Norm Stephens was called to speak. He advised the City is responsible for a \$13,500,000 Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District that encompasses the square mile from Kenosha to Houston and Elm Place to 9th Street. This TIF will be paid off by a combination of new property taxes generated by the TIF and new sales taxes in the TIF area.

Sales taxes collect for January, February, and March 2015 totaled \$55,084.62. Sales Tax collected in January, February, and March 2016 totalled \$81,239.74. Ad valorem taxes collected in January, February, and March 2016 was \$275,315.79, compared to \$234,374.91 collected in January, February and March 2015. Principal paid in 2016 is \$1,125,000.00 and Total Debt service paid is \$2,147,911.32.

Broken Arrow Economic Development Corporation has been chosen to be published in the National Real Estate Forum Publication for "Cinderella Stories" in development. This will be featured in their April issue and highlight transformation of the Rose District over the last five years.
