

ORDINANCE NO. 3490 - Corrected

An ordinance amending Chapter 16, Offenses-MISCELLANEOUS, Article III, Offenses Against Property, Section 16-56, Petit Larceny, amending the definition of Petit Larceny to be the taking of personal property of a value not to exceed \$1,000, amending the maximum punishment to be imprisonment of not more than 30 days, of the Broken Arrow Code; repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW:

SECTION I. That Chapter 16, Offenses-MISCELLANEOUS, Article III, Offenses Against Property, Section 16-56, Petit Larceny, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-56. - Petit larceny.

(a) Petit larceny is the taking of personal property of a value not to exceed \$1,000.00 accomplished (1) by fraud or by stealth or by flight; and (2) with intent to deprive another thereof.

(b) It shall be unlawful and punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment of not more than 30 days or both such fines and imprisonment for any person to commit petit larceny.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
