WHEREAS, CITY and ENGINEER propose to amend said ORIGINAL AGREEMENT to expand the project scope and compensation to include Utilities Laboratory ('Lab") upgrades.

WHEREAS, the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT and Amendments No. 1 through No. 3 shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as the "Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, funding is now available for said additional services; and

WHEREAS, ENGINEER is prepared to provide said additional services identified in this Amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. PROJECT SCOPE.

This Amendment requires CONSULTANT to revise the construction drawings to remove the fire rated wall; select furniture, fixture and equipment (FF&E); create documents for FF&E bidding; and provide construction administration services for FF&E installation.

2. CHANGE IN CONTRACT AMOUNT.

As compensation for the additional work, CITY shall pay ENGINEER in accordance with the terms as a change in the contract amount;
