Solid Waste and Recycling

The SW&R fleet represents 4% of all rolling stock fleet manages. Currently the SW&R trucks occupy 40% of the fleet departments overall time. Fridays are called trash truck Fridays!

By moving towards all automated trucks, we will free up time for the fleet department to spend on other vehicles such as police and fire.





- Average stops for the highest performers is 800 stops per day with rear load equipment.
 - → 1 Driver and 2 Helpers
- Average stops for high performers in a side loader is 1500 stops per day.
 - → 1 Driver
- That's almost twice the stops for a third of the staff. For the customer more with less keeps rate as low as possible for as long as possible.
- ASLs will significantly enhance performance, improve safety for staff operations, and provide better protection for staff against harsh weather conditions, including heat, cold, rain, and snow.
- Create new career paths as we send helpers to Tulsa Tech to become drivers (we have sent 5 so far with 3 more signed up)
- → The City can fully utilize the cart services we already bought.
- New opportunities for waste reduction and recycling!
