

Ordinance No. XXXX

An ordinance closing an easement on property located nearly one-half mile north of East Houston Street (81st Street), and one-fourth mile west of South 9th Street (177th E Avenue), Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, (Section 11, T18N, R14E); repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency (EASE-002666-2026)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. The easement affecting the real estate is described as follows:

See Utility Easement Partial Release – Exhibit “A”

is not presently in use, and is hereby closed. Provided that the City reserves the right to reopen this easement in the event it is needed in the future, without the necessity to pay the owner or their successors for the reopening of this utility easement.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
