This project will construct a new connector roadway between State Highway (SH)-51 and the proposed interchange with the Muskogee Turnpike and widen and reconstruct a 3-mile section of 273rd E. Avenue north of the Muskogee Turnpike. The Project involves three independent components.

- > Component 1 includes the construction of a new connector roadway between SH-51 and the proposed interchange with the Muskogee Turnpike.
- ➤ Component 2 includes improving 273rd E. Avenue by widening shoulders, adding curb and gutter, sidewalks, and a 12-foot flush media, and reconstructing intersections along 273rd E. Avenue.
- ➤ Component 3 includes replacing the existing bridge over the Muskogee Turnpike and constructing a new diamond interchange with the Muskogee Turnpike. Component 3 is being funded separately by the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) and not included in the project cost.
