

RESOLUTION NO. 1293

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1267, A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY TO CONDEMN PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 14 EAST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, FOR A COMMERCIAL STREET DETENTION FACILITY (PROJECT NO. SW2007) AND DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AN ALTERNATIVE LOCATION FOR A DOWNTOWN STORMWATER DETENTION FACILITY

WHEREAS, Dennis Sherwood owns or otherwise claims an interest in certain real property located on a tract of land in the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, T-18-N, R-14-E of the Indian Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; generally located at the Northwest corner of Date Avenue and Commercial Street, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2019, the Broken Arrow City Council approved Resolution No. 1267, a resolution of necessity to condemn property, in order to acquire said real property for the public purpose of completing a downtown stormwater detention facility; and

WHEREAS, the Broken Arrow City Council has determined it is currently in the public interest to pursue an alternative location for a downtown stormwater detention facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, that Resolution No. 1267 is rescinded and Staff is directed to investigate an alternative location for a downtown stormwater detention facility.
