## CITY OF BROKEN ARROW RESOLUTION NO. 1727

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF SOUTH 219<sup>TH</sup> EAST AVENUE ACROSS THE UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED IN SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 15 EAST OF THE INDIAN BASE AND MERIDIAN, GENERALLY LOCATED 2,170 FEET SOUTH OF EAST WASHINGTON STREET AND 1,130 FEET WEST OF SOUTH 51<sup>ST</sup> STREET (EVANS ROAD), WAGONER COUNTY, BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Broken Arrow plans to construct a new railroad crossing for South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to provide access to State Highway 51 from Events Park and the new Sunset Amphitheater; and

**WHEREAS**, through negotiations with the City, Union Pacific Railroad has agreed to allow construction of the new South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street railroad crossing contingent on closure of the existing South 219<sup>th</sup> East Avenue railroad crossing; and

**WHEREAS**, Union Pacific Railroad has agreed closure of the South 219<sup>th</sup> East Avenue railroad crossing would not be required until thirty days following the opening of the new South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street railroad crossing; and

WHEREAS, South 219<sup>th</sup> East Avenue would remain open, but dead end at Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, from both State Highway 51 and from East Gary Street for business access; and

**WHEREAS**, business, the park and school facility access would be maintained either via South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street or Events Park entrances from New Orleans Street to the south; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma the South 219<sup>th</sup> East Avenue roadway over the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way shall be permanently closed as described above.
