After the conclusion of the confidential portion of executive session, the Council will reconvene in open meeting, and the final decision, if any, will be put to a vote. In the opinion of the City Attorney, the Council is advised that disclosure will seriously impair the ability of the public body to process the pending tort claims, potential litigation and workers' compensation in the public interest. The Council is further advised that the Executive Session is necessary to protect the confidentiality of the businesses and also that disclosure will impair the ability of the City Council to process the pending appraisal and development of an economic development proposal in the public interest.
