- 2. PROJECT TITLE AND LOCATION: BROKEN ARROW GARDENS AT CENTRAL PARK LOCATED IN THE BROKEN ARROW CENTRAL PARK AT 1500 S MAIN ST, BROKEN ARROW, OK 74012.
- **3.** Contract for: Providing professional survey services associated with public works projects for the City of Broken Arrow. Professional services to include providing visual assessment of the site and drainage analysis, and plan sheets as necessary to construct site improvements and related support services. The Professional Service Provider shall perform all duties, responsibilities and requirements set out in Attachment A hereto. The Professional Service Provider agrees that this professional service shall be treated as an important service to the City and also agrees to commit the time necessary to perform the professional services in a professional manner.
- **4.** Compensation: Professional Service Provider shall be compensated for a lump sum total of Eight Thousand Four Hundred and No/100 (\$8,400.00) for the Design portion of work and Six Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$6,500) for the Survey portion of work for a total compensation under this contract of Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100 (\$14,900.00) for the entire Scope of the Professional Services rendered. The parties agree that the Professional Service Provider's position is not a traditional City employee position; therefore, the foregoing constitutes all the benefits and other forms of compensation due the Professional Service Provider, acting in the role of an independent contractor, and therefore ineligible for all other benefits paid to regular full-time City employees. The Professional Service Provider shall be responsible for his own vehicle expenses and any other indirect costs incurred in fulfilling the stated contract requirements. The Professional Service Provider agrees to abide by and comply with all of the City's Administrative Policies.
- **5. Invoicing and Payment**: The Professional Service Provider shall submit invoices requesting payment for services rendered to the City monthly in accordance with actual progress of the work on each work item. The invoices shall be in a format satisfactory to the City. Payment will be made within 30 days following the first eligible City Council meeting occurring after the date on the invoice.
- **6.** Time for Performance: These duties, responsibilities and requirements shall begin upon the execution of this Contract and shall be completed within sixty (60) calendar days after the date the

Notice to Proceed is issued. The City will issue a Notice to Proceed for each item of work identified under this agreement, following mutual agreement between the Professional Service Provider and the City on the hours required for the work item.

7. **Insurance**: The Professional Service Provider shall acquire all insurance policies required for professional liability insurance, general liability, auto insurance, workers' compensation and/or health insurance. The Professional Service Provider shall provide proof of general liability and professional liability insurance coverage to the City on or before the effective date of this Agreement.

During the performance of the services under this Professional Services Contract, the Professional Service Provider shall maintain the insurance coverage required below and the City shall be named as an Additional Insured on each required policy:

- (1) General Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate;
- (2) Automobile Liability Insurance, with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000 for each person, not less than \$1,000,000 for each accident and not less than \$1,000,000 for property damage; and
- (3) Professional Liability Insurance, with a limit of \$1,000,000 annual aggregate.
- **8. Indemnification:** The Professional Services Provider agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City, and its agents and employees, from and against legal liability for all claims, losses, damages, and expenses to the extent such claims, losses, damages, or expenses are caused by the negligent or intentional acts, errors, or omissions of The Professional Services Provider, its agents or employees.
- 9. Immigration Compliance: The Professional Service Provider shall comply in all respects with all immigration-related laws, statutes, ordinances and regulations including without limitation, the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended, the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, as amended, and the Oklahoma Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2007 (Oklahoma HB 1804) and any successor laws, ordinances or regulations (collectively, the Immigration Laws").
- 10. Governing Documents: The parties agree to perform this contract in strict accordance with the clauses, provisions, and the documents identified as follows, all of which are made part of this contract. In the event of conflict, these documents shall be interpreted in the following order:
 - a. This Contract
 - b. Attachment A to this Contract
 - c. Duly Authorized Amendments arising out of this Contract

11. Electronic Signatures:

The Parties agree this transaction may be completed by electronic means and an electronic

signature on this Contract will be given the same legal effect as a handwritten signature and cannot be denied enforceability solely because is it in electronic form. If the Professional Services Provider signs this Contract electronically and/or submits documents electronically, the Professional Services Provider agrees to comply with the City's requirements for submission of electronically signed and/or submitted documents.

- 12. Governing Law: This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma and venue for any action concerning this Agreement shall be in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
- 13. Entirety of Agreement: The foregoing Professional Services Contract supersedes all previous negotiations and may not be modified except by a written order executed by the parties hereto.
- 14. Effective Date: This Contract is effective shall be effective upon signature of both parties.

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ATTACHMENT A

SP - 1.0 SCOPE OF THE PROJECT:

1.1. Providing Professional Topographical Surveying, Site Assessment, Drainage Analysis, and prepare Plan Sheets for OWNER to construct the proposed improvements and Related Support Services associated with Gardens at Central Park located in Broken Arrow Central Park. Work performed under the contract shall be performed on a not to exceed contract as requested by the City.

SP- 2.0 SERVICES OF THE CITY: THE CITY WILL:

- 2.1. Furnish to Professional Service Provider all data in its possession, and needed engineering guidance as necessary for the service provider to complete the contract requirements.
- 2.2. Designate in writing a person to act as its representative in respect to the work to be performed under this agreement. Such person shall have complete authority to transmit instructions, receive information, interpret and define the City's policies and decisions with respect to materials, equipment, elements and systems pertinent to the services covered by this agreement.

SP - 3.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES: THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDER SHALL:

- 3.1 The Professional Service Provider shall provide a full topographic survey of the site to determine existing elevations and aid in proposed site grading. Horizontal and vertical control will be established for the project. Topographic survey will be tied to project control and include the following existing surface features: edge of pavement, curbs, drives, sidewalk, signs, fences, walls, flowerbeds, all visible drainage structures, and visible and/or marked utilities. Deliverable will include and electronic file in .dwg format containing the topographic items described and a DTM surface with contours at 1.0' minimum density. Items EXCLUDED from scope include: Right-of-Way research, property plotting, ALTA/NSPS Survey; Property/Boundary Survey(s); Survey Data Sheets; Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Services; Utility Relocations; Staking and any other item not explicitly stated in the previously described scope.
- 3.2 The Professional Service Provider shall provide a visual assessment of the site and drainage analysis to determine the best available options to improve drainage and will prepare plans sheets as necessary to allow the OWNER to construct the proposed improvements. These professional services will include: Construction cost estimates for repairs; Bidding/Construction Administration services; and Construction Inspections.
- 3.3 Work will be a not to exceed contract all costs associated with the performance of the work, including any support and supervision cost required from the Professional Service Provider
