In a typical month, how often do door-to-door peddlers or solicitors come to your home?

Number of votes per option:

Never	4% (109)
1 to 2 times	48% (1,377)
3 to 5 times	34% (973)
6 or more times	10% (287)

How effective are "No Soliciting" and/or "No Trespassing" signs (or HOA rules) posted on your property at stopping unwanted door-to-door peddlers at your home?

Number of votes per option:

Very effective	3% (77)
Somewhat effective	14% (406)

Have you or anyone in your household ever had a bad experience with a door-to-door solicitor who did not leave your property when asked, ignored your posted signs, or otherwise made you feel unsafe?

Yes	49% (1,428)
No	51% (1,458)

Do you support the City of Broken Arrow maintaining a No-Knock List containing the addresses of homes that residents have submitted indicating they do not want peddlers on their property and/or knocking on their door to sell goods and services between January 1st and December 31st? The list would NOT include the name of the property owner or resident(s) of the home. Participation would be voluntary.

If you want your address on a No-Knock List, would you be willing to submit it each year to appear on the list? The process would require an annual renewal (a simple online form on the City website) beginning on or after January 1st. The list would be provided each year to businesses that register for a door-to-door sales permit.

A No-Knock List is a registry of residents who voluntarily submitted their address because they do not want to be disturbed by people ringing their doorbell, knocking on their door, or otherwise contacting them in-person at their residence for the sale of goods or services.
