COBA FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

(SECTION 10-3)



- ▶ July 3rd and 4th Only
- ▶ No Permit Required
- ▶ Only Between the Hours of 3:00 PM and 11:00 PM
- ▶ Noncombustible Surfaces Only
- ▶ Individuals Must Clean Up all Fireworks Debris the Same Day
- ▶ Not Allowed to be Discharged:
 - ▶ In City Parks
 - ▶ In Arterial or Collector Streets over 26' Wide
 - ▶ Within 25' of any Permanent Structure
- ▶ Fines \$274 - \$549 Plus Court Costs

ROCKETS RED GLARE ACT

(SENATE BILL 1948)

- ▶ Went into effect May 29, 2026.
- ▶ “No county shall prohibit a private outdoor consumer fireworks for commercial purpose...”
- ▶ Allows for fireworks sales to occur year-round.
- ▶ Removes the ban on bottle rockets in Oklahoma.
- ▶ Effect on COBA Fireworks Ordinance:
 - ▶ City ordinances are still in effect
 - ▶ Sales of fireworks on property not in the city limits may occur all year round.
 - ▶ Bottle rockets are now allowed, subject to existing city ordinances.



OPERATIONAL ACTION PLAN

 - ▶ **4 Enforcement Teams**
 - ▶ **Daytime – Focus on Parks and Commercial Businesses**
 - ▶ **Evening – Focus on After 11:00 PM**

- ▶ **July 5th**
 - ▶ **One Enforcement Team**
 - ▶ **Focus on Citizen Complaints and After 11:00 PM**



OPERATIONAL ACTION PLAN

- ▶ **July 1st and 2nd**
 - ▶ **2 Officers Assigned to Work Enforcement**
 - ▶ **Field Calls for Fireworks Related Offenses**
- ▶ **July 3rd and 4th**
 - ▶ **Patrol Officers will Handle Calls for Service**
 - ▶ **Focus will be on Violators outside City Ordinance (Times/Locations)**
- ▶ **July 5th**
 - ▶ **2 Officers Assigned to Work Enforcement**
 - ▶ **Field Calls for Fireworks Related Offenses**
