

ORDINANCE NO. 3305

An ordinance amending the zoning ordinance of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, approving BAZ 1894, granting PUD 221 and Industrial Light zoning classification be placed upon the tracts, repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma has granted cities, as governmental entities, the duty and power to enact zoning ordinances for the protection of persons and property residing within the City limits, and for securing the benefits of orderly development as a whole; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2013, a series of governmental administrative hearings were conducted at which time it was determined that the land in question would be proper for an Industrial Light District, along with PUD 221, subject to the property being platted; and

WHEREAS, the plat, Molded Products, was recorded in Wagoner County on June 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the property is located west of Evans Road, south of State Highway 51; and

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning is compatible with the comprehensive plan and surrounding uses; and

WHEREAS, the granting of the application will not have an adverse effect on the other property in the area or in the community; and

WHEREAS, for these reasons, the City Council finds this request should be granted.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. The zoning classification of the following described real estate situated in Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma, being more particularly described as follows:

Legal Description for BAZ 1894 and PUD 221

All of Molded Products located in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Fifteen (15) East, an addition to the City of Broken Arrow, Wagoner County, Oklahoma

be and the same is hereby changed from the zoning classification of A-1 to IL and PUD 221.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

PASSED AND APPROVED and the emergency clause ruled upon separately this 6th day of October, 2015.
