On August 18, 2025 OWRB staff met with your staff regarding the City of Broken Arrow floodplain management program and participation in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). I want to thank you for the courtesy extended to my staff during the visit.

The OWRB coordinates the NFIP and assists communities each year with floodplain management activities as part of this program. This Community Assistance Visit (CAV) was performed under the 2025 OWRB Community Assistance Program funded in part by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

During the CAV, the special flood hazard area (SFHA) in your community was inspected for new and recent past floodplain development. Your community regulations and procedures for implementation of its floodplain management program were also evaluated. We found no deficiencies in your community.
