The Museum Broken Arrow is a Non-profit 501(c)(3) organization



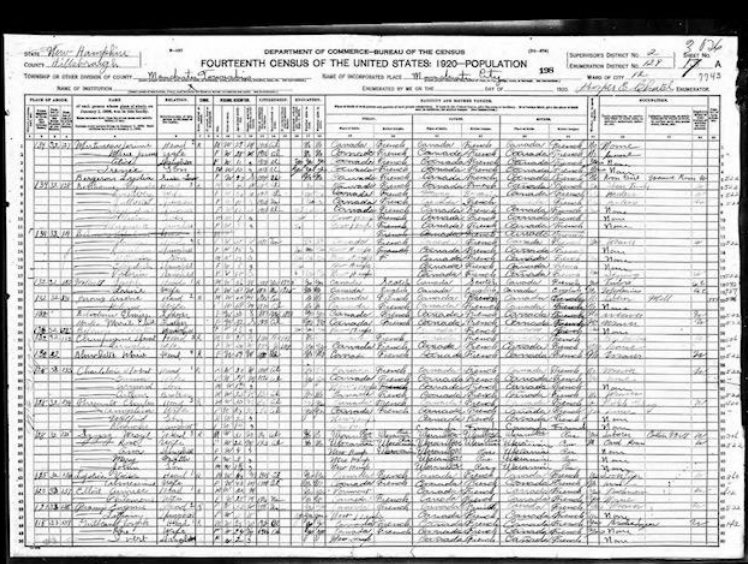
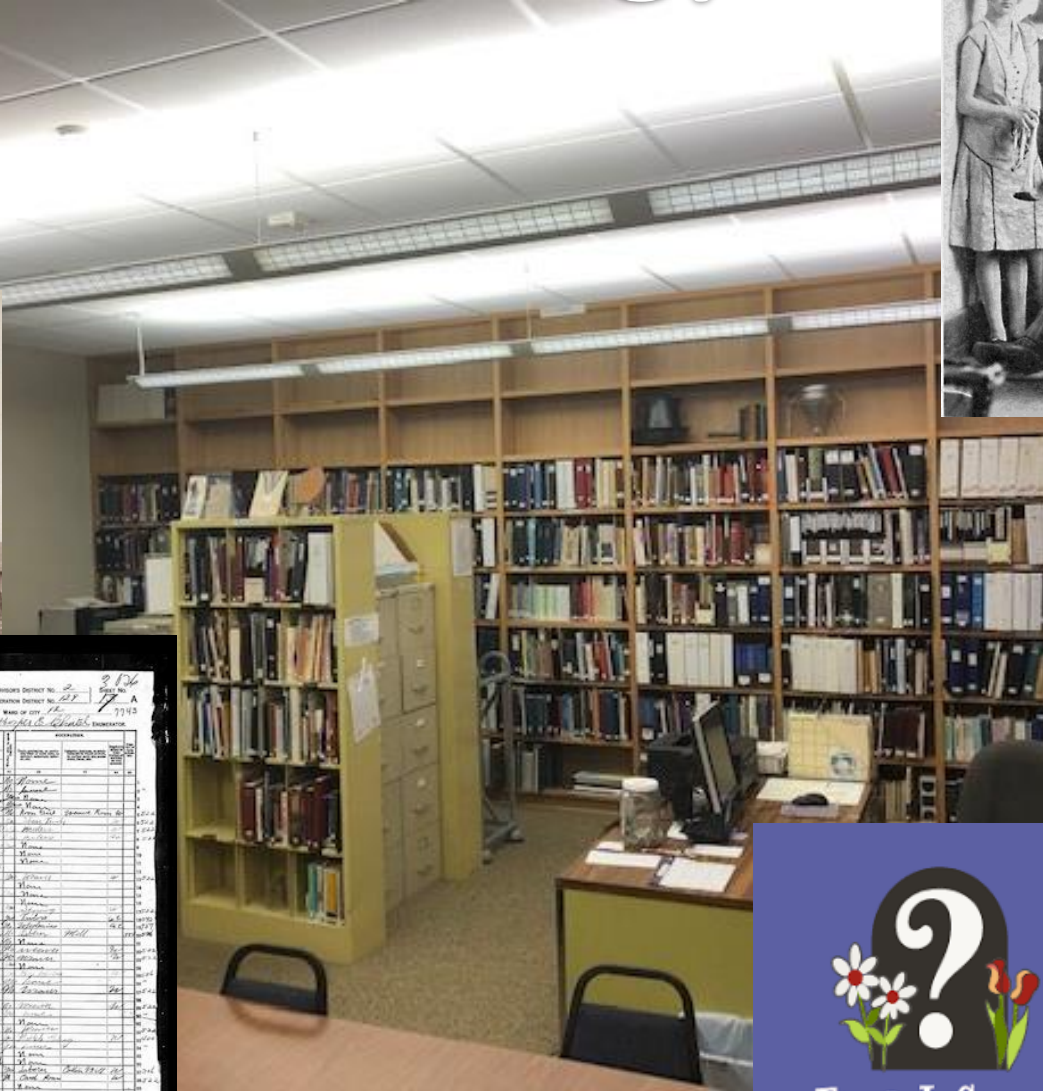

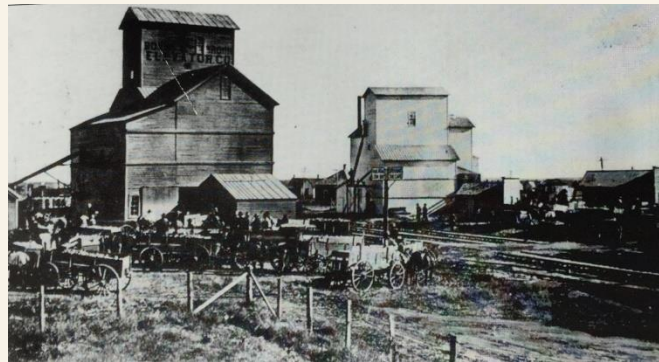
Who comes to visit YOUR local Museum/Historical society?
