#### 7. Remarks and Inquiries by Governing Body Members

City Manager Michael Spurgeon thanked Chamber President James Bell and the Economic Development Corporation (EDC) for providing the city's workforce development and investment data. The information highlighted significant private investment and job creation. Additionally, Mr. Spurgeon shared that approximately 500,000 square feet of new retail and commercial space are under planning, permitting, or construction stages, reflecting strong private sector confidence in the city's potential. Specific projects, such as Aspen Ridge with 81,000 square feet of permitted retail space, were mentioned as examples of ongoing developments. These efforts will enhance local shopping opportunities and further community growth in 2025.

Trustee Lisa Ford shared their excitement about a new pickleball business opening in Broken Arrow after a tour with Mayor Wimpee. They noted the business's praise for the city's staff, describing them as the easiest to work with compared to other locations. The positive feedback highlights Broken Arrow's business-friendly environment, encouraging more businesses to consider the city a welcoming destination.
