

RESOLUTION NO. 1567

A RESOLUTION OF THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A JOINT APPLICATION FOR THE OPIOID ABATEMENT GRANT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW AND THE BROKEN ARROW PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma sued opioid manufacturers and distributors for their role in the opioid crisis and subsequently received settlement funds. The Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board oversees distribution of settlement funds. Political Subdivisions have the opportunity to submit an application and apply for a portion of these funds; and

WHEREAS, the city of Broken Arrow and Broken Arrow Public Schools intend to submit a joint application that aims to save lives of those otherwise at risk of substance abuse disorder, use evidence-based practices to improve outcomes, and invest in youth education and prevention; and

WHEREAS, and a Resolution of the governing body is required to submit an application; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW the City is authorized to file an joint Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Award Application between the City of Broken Arrow and Broken Arrow Public Schools that will assist in providing education to students in Broken Arrow of the dangers of Opioids, the Opioid Forums with the Broken Arrow Public Schools will provide education to the parents and community on the dangers of opioids and open a line of communication between our students, community, and police department, and the Narcotics Analyzers will keep our police officers safer.

This Resolution is approved in open meeting by the City Council of the City of Broken Arrow on this 2nd day of April 2024.
