

**Ordinance No. 3605**

**An Ordinance closing a portion of Right-of-Way on property located one-quarter mile north of Washington Street (91st Street), one-quarter mile west of 225th East Avenue (Evans Road), Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma, (Section 18, T18N, R15E) (Creek 51 Business Park) (North); repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA:**

**SECTION I.** The right-of-way affecting the real estate described as follows:

See "Exhibits A.3 and A.4"

is not presently in use, and is hereby closed. Provided that the City reserves the right to reopen this right-of-way in the event it is needed in the future, without the necessity to pay the owner or their successors for the reopening of this utility easement.

**SECTION II.** Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION III.** An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.

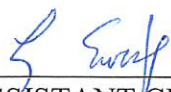
