#### WITNESSETH:

**WHEREAS**, said ORIGINAL AGREEMENT requires CONSULTANT to develop programming, investigation, Conceptual Design and Site Selection for a new Broken Arrow City Hall.

**WHEREAS**, CITY and ENGINEER propose to amend said ORIGINAL AGREEMENT to expand the project scope and compensation to revise conceptual survey to Topographic/ALTA survey with additional services.

**WHEREAS**, the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT and Amendments No. 1 through No. 2 shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as the "Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, funding is now available for said additional services; and

**WHEREAS**, ENGINEER is prepared to provide said additional services identified in this Amendment.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

#### 1. PROJECT SCOPE.

This Amendment requires CONTRACTOR to provide ALTA/NSPA with Topographic Survey, Utility Electronic Locates and an Easement Report.

#### 2. CHANGE IN CONTRACT AMOUNT.

As compensation for the additional work, CITY shall pay ENGINEER in accordance with the terms as a change in the contract amount;

#### COMPENSATION AND ADDITIONAL SERVICES

#### 1.0 BASIC COMPENSATION
