



**REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
EMERGENCY BYPASS OPERATIONS
HAIKEY CREEK TRUNK LINE REPAIRS
Broken Arrow, OK; Tulsa County
Butternut Ave. North of Florence Ave (111th St.)**

Date: July 25, 2025

It is the intent of The City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma (hereinafter referred to as “City”) of this Request for Proposal to secure on a quote basis, a specialty professional sewer bypass contractor to assist the City of Broken Arrow in a partial day fully bypass project on the Haikey Creek Trunk line just north of Florence Ave just east of Garnett Rd. The specialty contractor shall commit equipment and resources on an emergency basis to meet the Cities accelerated schedule for repairs tentatively scheduled for Thursday, July 30, 2025. The bypass operation is in coordination with the repairs of a partially collapsed 48” gravity sewer main, see attached bypass plans and attached record drawings for reference.

The specialty contractor shall provide and install all bypass pumping equipment to complete required operation of fully bypassing the 48” gravity sewer for approximately 1200 linear feet at a maximum flow rate of 4.5 MGD. The contractor will also provide and facilitate the installation of an appropriate sewer plug at bypass location. Additionally, the contractor shall initiate and operate the bypass system during the Cities repairs of the sewer line.

The City of Broken Arrow will provide labor and large lifting equipment such as facilitating the contractors installation, operation, and demobilization of the sewer bypass.

Proposed base pricing for services may be disclosed at a public meeting to receive and file responses to this and other solicitations, and at the Broken Arrow City Council Meeting. Purchases or contractual agreements of this nature require the expenditure of public funds and/or use of public facilities; therefore, it should be noted that all other information provided in your response will be considered proprietary and will not be divulged during the proposal review process. The successful proposer shall understand, however, that portions (potentially all) of their proposal (including any final contracts) will become public record after acceptance by the City of Broken Arrow City Council.
