

**RESOLUTION NO. 1740**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA, RECOGNIZING AND SUPPORTING THE CITY'S ROLE AS HOST OF THE 2026 NATIONAL LEAGUE OF CITIES AND OKLAHOMA MUNICIPAL LEAGUE WOMEN IN MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT CONFERENCES, AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE VALUE AND PRIORITIES OF WOMEN IN MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Broken Arrow is honored to serve as the host community for the 2026 National League of Cities (NLC) and Oklahoma Municipal League (OML) Annual Women in Municipal Government (WiMG) Conferences, to be held June 22–26, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, Women in Municipal Government brings together female municipal leaders from across the nation to network, collaborate, and share best practices that strengthen local governance; and

**WHEREAS**, the WiMG Conferences provide a dedicated space for women municipal officials and staff to exchange ideas, address common challenges, and celebrate their professional achievements and contributions to their communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2026 Women in Municipal Government Conferences will focus on the following priority areas:

1. Advancing economic opportunity for women through workforce development;
2. Uplifting community well-being by advancing health, wellness, and quality-of-life initiatives; and
3. Advocating for civility and public safety for municipal officials; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Broken Arrow proudly supports these priorities and recognizes the impact of strong, engaged women leaders in municipal government who contribute daily to the success and vitality of communities across Oklahoma and the nation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA:**

**THAT** this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.


