## **RESOLUTION NO. 1631**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO DEFEND SCOTT BENNETT IN THE MATTER OF JOHN WINNINGHAM, JR., ET AL., V. CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, ET AL., CASE NO. 24-CV-62-JDR, IN THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF OKLAHOMA

**WHEREAS,** on February 15, 2024, John Winningham, Jr. filed a Complaint against Defendants, the City of Broken Arrow, Scott Bennett, Leon Rademacher and Tiffany Jessie for claims of conspiracy, abuse of process, malicious prosecution, theft and fraud; and

**WHEREAS,** Deputy Chief Scott Bennett has complied with the provisions of 11 O.S. § 23-102 and requested that the City of Broken Arrow defend him in this matter; and

**WHEREAS,** Deputy Chief Scott Bennett was acting in good faith and in the course of his employment with the City of Broken Arrow; and

**WHEREAS,** 11 O.S. § 23-101 *et seq.* provides for the defense of such municipal employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to appear and defend Deputy Chief Scott Bennett in the matter of *Winningham*, et al., v. COBA et. al., Case No. 24-CV-62-JDR, in the Northern District of Oklahoma.
