Possible litigation and pending claims regarding Lamar Outdoor Advertising and the removal of billboards from the City right-of-way located north of the Broken Arrow Expressway, along West Fargo Street, west of Aspen Avenue and possible litigation against Nikel Investment, LLC for possible breach of a July 15, 2008 Development and License Agreement between the City of Broken Arrow and Nikel related to the removal of Lamar Outdoor Advertising billboards from the City right-of-way, and possible action in open session, including authority to initiate an action against Nikel Investment, LLC and/or Lamar Outdoor Advertising under 25 O.S. §307(B)(4).
- 4. The appraisal of real property, claims and potential litigation for the real property located at 4014 West Pittsburg Circle, Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, and city infrastructure and possible action in open session, including authorization to negotiate for acquisition and resolving the claims of this real property under 25 O.S. §307(B)(3) and 25 O.S. §307(B)(4).

After the conclusion of the confidential portion of executive session, the Council will reconvene in open meeting and the final decisions if any will be put to a vote. In the opinion of the City Attorney, the Council is advised that disclosure will seriously impair the ability of the public body to process the potential litigation and pending claims in the public interest. Also, in the opinion of the City Attorney the Executive Session is necessary to protect the confidentiality of the proposed businesses.
