### **Background:**

On November 4, 2014, the City Council and Economic Development Authority approved a Ground Lease with Stoney Creek Hospitality Corporation for the purpose of building a hotel and convention center. The Ground Lease provided a term of 75 years, along with one, 24-year extension. The Lease further requires Stoney Creek to construct a hotel consisting of approximately 150,000 square feet and containing 170 guest rooms. It also requires Stoney Creek to construct a convention center consisting of approximately 35,000-40,000 square foot. The total cost of the hotel and conference/convention center is projected to be approximately \$23,550,000.

The First Amendment to the Ground Lease corrects the legal description and brings it into compliance with the closing documents and the Economic Development Agreement. Staff recommends that the Council approve the First Amendment to Ground Lease and authorize its execution

### FIRST AMENDMENT TO GROUND LEASE

This First Amendment to GROUND LEASE (the "First Amendment") is made and effective as of this 18<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2016, by and between **THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW**, **OKLAHOMA** an Oklahoma Municipal Corporation (together with its successors and assigns, the "City," which term, when used in such context, shall also mean and refer to the areas within the territorial limits of the City), **BROKEN ARROW ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**, an Oklahoma Public Trust of which the City is sole Beneficiary (together with its successors and assigns "BAEDA"), and **STONEY CREEK HOSPITALITY CORPORATION**, an Iowa corporation (together, with its successors and assigns, the "Developer").

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2014, the City, BAEDA, and Stoney Creek entered into an Economic Development Agreement ("2014 Agreement") and a Ground Lease ("2014 Lease") whereby certain Premises were made available to Stoney Creek for location of a conference/convention center and an accompanying hotel; and

WHEREAS, the advancement of the Project has resulted in the need to amend the 2014 Lease in order to more effectively document the intent of the parties and to resolve an issue necessitated by construction of the Project (as defined in Article I of the 2014 Lease); and

**WHEREAS**, Exhibit A to the, 2014 Lease has been modified to more fully reflect the intent of the parties and, as such, is addressed by this First Amendment and incorporated into the 2014 Lease (as amended by this First Amendment, the "Lease"), i.e. the legal description attached as **Exhibit A** hereto, to be substituted in whole for Exhibit A to the 2014 Lease; and

**WHEREAS**, both the City and BAEDA deem it appropriate to approve the execution and delivery of this First Amendment in the interest of providing for the implementation of the Project and have determine such actions are in the best interest of the City and the health, safety, and welfare of the City and residents within and near the City; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the covenants and mutual obligations set out herein and in the 2014 Lease, and other consideration, the sufficiency of which the parties hereby acknowledge, the parties hereto hereby covenant and agree to the following Amendment:

**Legal Description of the Land.** Following the execution and delivery of the 2014 Lease, it was necessary to refine and revise the legal description of the land and the parties agree that **Exhibit A**, as attached hereto and made a part hereof, shall become and be Exhibit A to the 2014 Lease.

# ARTICLE A EXHIBITS AND SCHEDULES

## ARTICLE B CONTINUING TERMS OF AGREEMENT

B.1 Except as hereby amended hereby, all terms of the 2014 Lease remain in full force and effect without modification or change. The 2014 Lease, as amended herein, is in all respects ratified and confirmed and shall be read, take and construed as one in the same instrument

### **Background:**

On November 15, 2014, the City of Broken Arrow, The Broken Arrow Economic Development Authority, and Stoney Creek Hospitality Corporation, entered into a comprehensive Economic Development Agreement and Ground Lease for the development of a conference/convention center and accompanying hotel. Both the Agreement and the Lease allowed the Developer to assign its interests to an affiliated party without formal approval by the City Council or the Authority. On May 13, 2016, the City received notification of Stoney Creek Hospitality Corporation's Assignment and Assumption to Stoney Creek Investors of Broken Arrow, L.L.C. ("Stoney Creek").

In addition to the land purchase price, which came from approved General Obligation Bond proceeds, the City of Broken Arrow, through Vision Surplus Funds, contributed the sum of \$6,335,573.33 to this project for the purposes of grading, infrastructure, engineering design, architectural design and construction of utilities, among other things. In order to complete the hotel and conference center, it was always contemplated that the Developer would need to obtain financing secured by a mortgage of the real property and the improvements. In order to finalize the process, Stoney Creek has requested approval of the attached Ground Lessor Estoppel Certificate. The Legal Department has reviewed the Certificate and found it acceptable.

#### GROUND LESSOR ESTOPPEL CERTIFICATE

This Ground Lessor Estoppel Certificate ("Estoppel") is dated \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2016, on behalf of the City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, an Oklahoma municipal corporation (the "City"), and Broken Arrow Economic Development Authority, an Oklahoma public trust of which the City is sole beneficiary ("BAEDA"), for the benefit of Guaranty Abstract Company ("Escrow Agent") and Old Republic National Title Insurance Company ("Underwriter").

Craig Thurmond, being duly sworn, on oath affirms that the following statements are true:

- 1. I am the Mayor of the City and Chairman of BAEDA. The City, as fee owner of the land described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Land") and ground lessor, and BAEDA are parties to that certain Ground Lease dated November 4, 2014, and amended on October 18, 2016, (the Lease"), by and among the City, BAEDA and Stoney Creek Hospitality Corporation, an Iowa corporation ("Developer"), as ground tenant.
- 2. The Lease has not been modified since October 18, 2016, except that the Developer's interest under the Lease has been assigned to Stoney Creek Investors of Broken Arrow, L.L.C., an Iowa limited liability company, pursuant to Assignment and Assumption Agreement dated May 24, 2016.
- 3. As of the date of this Estoppel:
  - (a) The Lease is in full force and effect in accordance with its terms and has not been assigned, supplemented, modified or otherwise amended, except as set forth in paragraph 2 above.
  - (b) To the best knowledge of the City and BAEDA, each of the obligations of the Developer to be performed to date under the Lease have been performed.
  - (c) To the best knowledge of the City and BAEDA no event has occurred that constitutes a "Default" (as defined in the Lease) on the part of the Developer.
- 4. The representations herein are made to induce Escrow Agent and Underwriter to issue one or more policies of title insurance affecting the Land and affiant acknowledges on behalf of the City and BAEDA that Escrow Agent and Underwriter are relying upon the truth of such representations. In consideration thereof, the City and BAEDA hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Escrow Agent and Underwriter from any claims, costs, damages, causes of action, expenses and attorney's fees in any way arising from the inaccuracy of the representations made herein.
