## **ORDINANCE NO. 3728**

An ordinance amending Chapter 2, Administration, Article I, In General, Sec. 2-13. – Members of boards and commissions, specifically changing the name of the Broken Arrow Convention and Visitors' Bureau (CVB) to Visit Broken Arrow, repealing all ordinances to the contrary and declaring an emergency.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW:

**SECTION I.** Broken Arrow Code Chapter 2, Administration, Article I, In General, Sec. 2-13. – Members of Boards and commissions, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Sec. 2-13. – Members of boards and commissions.

- (a) Appointments. The members of the planning commission, the members of the board of adjustment, and the members of such other boards and commissions as the city council may from time to time create, shall be nominated, and appointed pursuant to ordinance. The council may decide upon the proposed appointment by a majority vote of the quorum present and voting. Failure to reach a decision upon a proposed appointment shall not prevent action thereon at a later regularly scheduled meeting of the council.
- (b) Removal from office. The council may remove members of the planning commission, board of adjustment, and such other boards and commissions as they may from time to time create, for cause; provided, that any individual whose removal is being considered by the council shall be entitled to notice and an opportunity to be heard prior to the decision to remove said individual.
- (c) *Residency*. All members of the planning commission, board of adjustment, and all permanent or standing boards and commissions except for the Visit Broken Arrow board, must reside within the city during their terms of office. Members of temporary boards or commissions must reside within the city during their term of office unless this requirement is waived by the council.

**SECTION II.** Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION III**. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
