## Instructions to Bidders

To be considered, bids must be made in accordance with these Instructions to Bidders.

1.01 <u>CONDITIONS RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION</u>: Bidders shall carefully examine the bid documents and the construction site to obtain first-hand knowledge of existing conditions. Bidder must confirm all utility locations, sizes, pressure, etc., and satisfy himself as to existing conditions under which he will be obliged to operate. Contractor must employ such methods and means in carrying out the work as will not cause interruption or interference with any other Contractor of the Owner. Bidders shall not be given extra payments for conditions that can be determined by examining the site and bid documents.

The scope of work for this bid is Bid Package #	
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1.02 INTERPRETATION OR CORRECTION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS: Should a Bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from, the bid documents, or be in doubt as to their meaning, he must notify the Construction Manager in writing five (5) working days prior to the bid opening. Replies shall be issued to all bidders or record by Addendum or CM Clarification to the bid documents and shall become part of the contract. The Owner shall not be responsible for oral clarification. All addenda or CM Clarification items issued during the time of bidding shall be covered in the bid and acknowledged on the proposal.

The Contract and Bidding Documents will be available at Gill Reprographics and on <a href="www.isqft.com">www.isqft.com</a>. Copies of the contract and bidding documents may also be reviewed at Southwest Construction News, the Project site, and at the Construction Manager's Office located at 2501 N Hemlock Court in Broken Arrow.

## 1.03 SUBSTITUTIONS:

- A. The materials, products, and equipment described in the Documents establish a standard of required function, dimension, appearance, and quality to be met by any proposed substitution. To obtain approval to use unspecified products, the Bidder shall submit a written request at least five (5) working days before the bid date. Requests shall clearly describe the product for which approval is asked including all data necessary to demonstrate acceptability.
- B. Basic data and characteristics of the specified items, as well as the proposed item, shall be submitted. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to submit complete descriptive and technical information so the Owner may make a proper appraisal. The burden of proof of the merit of the proposed substitute is upon the proposer. The Architect's decision of approval or disapproval of a proposed substitution shall be final. If the product is acceptable, the Architect shall approve it in an addendum issued to all prime bidders of record. Bidders shall not rely upon approvals made in any other manner.
- 1.04 <u>BASIS OF BID</u>: Proposals will be made of a single contract, lump-sum amount for all work shown or described in the contract documents.
- 1.05 <u>BID SECURITY</u>: Bid security shall be made payable to City of Broken Arrow in the amount of five percent of the bid sum. Security shall be either certified check or a bid bond issued by a surety license to conduct business in the State of Oklahoma. The successful Bidder's security shall be retained until he has signed the contract and furnished the required Labor and Material Payment Bond, Statutory Bond, Performance Bond, Defect Bond, Insurance Certificates, and all other documents required to be furnished with the Executed Contract Agreement. The Owner reserves the right to retain the security of all Bidders until the successful Bidder enters into a contract or until 60 days after the bid opening, whichever is the shorter. All other bid security shall be returned as soon as practical. If any

Bidder refuses to enter into a contract; the Owner shall retain his bid security as liquidated damages, but not as a penalty. The bid security is to be enclosed in the same envelope with the bid proposals. Any Bidder (materials only or materials and installation) whose total bid amount is less than \$50,000.00 is not required to furnish bid bond with their bid.

- 1.06 PERFORMANCE BOND, LABOR AND MATERIAL PAYMENT BOND AND DEFECT BOND: Bidders shall not include the cost of bonds in the base bid. The bonding cost will be provided as an add alternate listed on the bid packages in the space provided. The successful Bidder whose Total Contract Scope of Work is more than \$50,000 will be required to furnish bonds in such form as the Owner may prescribe and with a surety company acceptable to the Owner. Bidder's bond surety shall be listed in the current revision of U.S. Department of Treasury Circular, "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds." The Bidder shall deliver said bonds to the Construction Manager no later than the date of execution of the contract. Failure or neglecting to deliver said bonds, as specified, shall be retained as liquidated damages. Bonds shall be written for the sum equal to the contract price, including accepted alternate bids.
- 1.07 CONTRACTORS: There shall be only one contractor named for each classification listed.
- 1.08 <u>BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION STATEMENT</u>: Each prospective Bidder may be required to submit a Contractor's Qualification Statement, AIA Document to the Construction Manager after the bid opening. Submittal of an advertising brochure is not permitted. Such statement shall be notarized. A financial statement is not required with the qualification statement; however, the apparent three lowest bidders may be required to submit a notarized current statement within 72 hours after the bid opening.
- 1.09 <u>MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL</u>: Bids may not be modified after submittal. Bidders may withdraw bids at any time before bid opening. No bid may be withdrawn or modified after the bid opening except where the award of the contract has been delayed for **60 days**.

## 1.10 FORM OF PROPOSAL:

- A. Before submitting the proposal, carefully examine all bid documents, visit the site, examine existing conditions and limitations, and include a sum to cover the costs of all items included in the bid documents. Failure or omission of the Bidder to receive or examine any form, instrument, addendum or other document, or to visit the site and acquaint themselves with existing conditions shall not relieve the Bidder from obligations with respect to his bid or to contract requirements. Submission of the Form of Proposal shall be taken as prima fascia evidence of compliance with this division.
- B. Proposals shall be made only on the form provided in these specifications. Blank spaces on the form shall be fully filled out, numbers stated both in writing and figures, signatures signed in longhand, and form completed without interlineations, alteration or erasure. Oral, telegraphic or telephonic proposals or modifications shall not be accepted.

## 1.11 PROPOSAL PROCEDURE:

- B. The Bidder, by his failure to include every listed Item 2 through 7 above within the sealed envelope and label information as required in Items 1 and 2, may forfeit his right to have his bid considered.
- C. Each Bidder shall propose an additive or deductive sum to the base bid sum for each alternate included in each Bid Package, except that should he desire not to bid an alternate he may insert the words "No Bid" in the space provided for price for such alternate. However, when a Bidder writes "No Bid" for one or more alternates, he thereby waives any claim to the contract award if that alternate becomes the basis for determining the low bid and/or the contract award. If an alternate price called for involves no change in price, Bidder shall so indicate by writing the words "No Change" in the space provided.
- D. Proposals shall not contain any recapitulation of the work to be done.
- E. Proposals shall be delivered to place designated in the Invitation to Bidders on or before the day and hour set for the opening of bids. The proposal shall be in an opaque, sealed envelope, bearing the Bid Package number(s) and the name of the Bidder. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to deliver the proposal before the scheduled closing time. Bids received after the scheduled closing time shall be returned unopened.
- F. Prices shall include the furnishing of materials, equipment, tools and all other facilities and performance of labor and services necessary for proper completion of the work. In the event of discrepancy between prices quoted in words and those quoted in figures, words shall govern.
- G. Addenda: Any addenda issued during the time of bidding are to be acknowledged in the proposal; in executing a contract, they will become a part thereof.
- H. CM Clarification: Any CM Clarifications issued during the time of bidding are to be acknowledged in the proposal; in executing a contract, they will become a part thereof.

## 1.12 EXCECUTION OF CONTRACT:

- A. The City of Broken Arrow anticipates award of the contract for construction on the basis of the lowest, responsible bid, including any alternates accepted, which the Owner deems to be in its best interest.
- B. Upon the request of the Owner, a Bidder whose bid is under consideration for award of contract

- shall submit promptly to the Owner satisfactory evidence indicating the Bidder's construction experience and organization available for performance of the contract.
- C. Each Bidder shall be prepared, upon execution of the contract agreement, to commence work following receipt of his written order of the Owner to proceed.
- D. Tax Exempt Status: Pursuant to qualifying the Bidder and his subcontractors for appointment as agents for purchasing materials and equipment to be incorporated into the project exempt from state sales tax, in accordance with Oklahoma Tax Commission Order dated May 21, 1992, the Owner will attach the list of subcontractors submitted with the proposal of the successful Bidder as Exhibit "A" to the Contract for Construction.

The Owner is tax exempt for all city, county and state sales tax for this project.

- 1.13 <u>CONTRACT</u>: The form of agreement, which the successful Bidder, as Contractor, shall be required to execute is the Magnum Construction, Inc. Standard Subcontract Agreement, which is attached as Document 00500; or the Magnum Construction, Inc. Standard Purchase Agreement, which is attached as Document 00501.
- 1.14 <u>APPLICATION AND CERTIFICATE FOR PAYMENT:</u> The successful Contractor/Supplier will be required to complete, notarize and submit their Invoices on a monthly basis using the Magnum Construction, Inc. Application for Payment form.

One original payment application shall be submitted to the Construction Manager for approval not later than the date set forth in the contract. Any application received after that date will be returned unpaid to the Contractor/Supplier for re-submission the following month.

Payment for retainage must be invoiced using these same forms upon project completion. Along with the retainage application of payment, the Receipt and Release Forms must accompany application for payment.

- 1.15 NON-KICKBACK STATEMENT (Affidavit for Payment of Claims): The successful Subcontractor/Supplier will be required to complete the Non-Kickback Statement and submit it, notarized, with each monthly application for payment. Failure to provide this executed and notarized document with the monthly payment application will cause the pay application to be returned unpaid for re-submission the following month. An example of this document is included.
- 1.16 COMPLETION TIME: It is agreed that work performed under this contract shall commence when the Notice to Proceed has been distributed by Magnum Construction, Inc. and that the work shall be substantially completed for beneficial occupancy within the time provided in accordance with the Project Schedule. Beginning date, construction rate of progress and time for completion are essential conditions of the contract. The Bidder agrees work shall be performed regularly, diligently and uninterrupted at such a rate of progress as to ensure a complete job within the time specified in accordance with the schedule for construction and issued as part of the bidding Documents. It is expressly agreed that the time for completion is a reasonable time, considering conditions prevailing in the region of the project. Abnormal weather, except for an act of God, shall not be a consideration. Prior to beginning work, but not later than 45 days after Notice to Proceed, subcontractors are to submit detailed sequencing schedules to the Construction Manager for incorporation into the project planning and master schedule. Schedules are to be broken down by floor and building zone in such detail that indicates sequencing of work, exterior and interior of the building, under slab, in-wall, overhead, roughin, supports, mains, branches, valves, equipment, switches, controls, testing, flushing, balancing, training, start-up, and commissioning of each system being installed as applicable to the subcontractor's discipline of work.

- 1.17 <u>WORK UNDER THIS CONTRACT</u>: Includes all required permits, fees, material, labor, tools, expendable equipment, transportation services, daily cleanup, and all incidental items necessary to perform and complete all of the work required as indicated on the drawings and/or specified herein.
- 1.18 NON-USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS POLICY: By submission of Bidding Documents, bidder understands that the construction site is covered by Magnum Construction's Safety Policy & Procedures.
- 1.19 PRE-BID CONFERENCE: PRE-BID to be held April 26, 2016 @ 2:00 p.m. at The City of Broken Arrow City Hall at 220 South 1st Street. Broken Arrow, OK 74012

The purpose of the pre-bid conference will be to review the bid documents and procedures and to receive Bidders' questions. Response to questions, which are not addressed in the bid documents or require modification, will be included in an addendum.

## 1.20 COMPLIANCE WITH PUBLIC COMPETITIVE BID ACT:

- A. All Bidders and Sub-Bidders must comply fully with all the Laws of Oklahoma and ensure that the project adheres to all of the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 of the State of Oklahoma, as most recently amended.
- A. The Non-Collusion and Business Relationships Affidavits required to be included with all proposals are included in the Contract Documents. These Affidavits must be executed and submitted with the bid.

## 1.21 PROOF OF INSURANCE:

Bidder must supply proof of insurance for General Liability and Workman's Compensation, City of Broken Arrow and Magnum Construction, Inc. must be listed as additional insured. Insurance requirements are in Magnum Construction's sample Subcontract Agreement (00500-5).

## 1.22 **SAFTEY**:

OSHA 29CFR 1926 and Magnum Construction's Safety Policy & Procedures will be the project safety requirement. If conflicting information is found, then the more stringent will rule. Copies of both are on file at the Construction Manager's office for review.

- 16. <u>Question:</u> Sheet A701 J&H. Is the wall behind the desk furred out with drywall or is this a millwork paneled wall? <u>Answer:</u> The wall is furred out drywall. See revised Partition Types.

- 17. Request: S General note #32 on sheet E-101 states to use healthcare rated MC. Can standard 12/2 MC w/ ground be substituted for the healthcare rated MC cable? Attached is a cutsheet of the MC cable proposed.

  Response: Yes, this cable is acceptable.
- 18. <u>Request:</u> General note #32 on sheet E-101 states to use flexible metallic tubing to connect to light fixtures. Can MC cable be used to make final connections to light fixtures? Response: Yes, this is acceptable.
- Request: Alternate Lighting Substitution Package
   Response: Bidders are to provide price for lighting as listed on the construction documents. Bidders can provide alternate lighting packages as deductive alternate.

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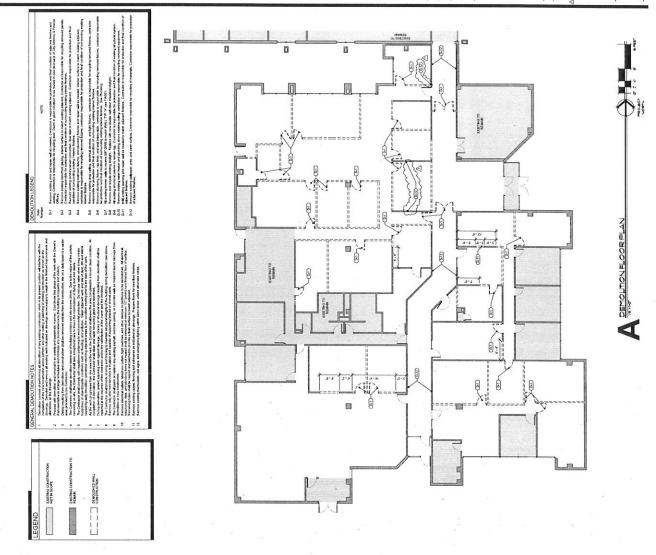
