Ordinance No. 3450

An ordinance amending the Broken Arrow Code, Chapter 23, Traffic, Article II, Operation of vehicles, generally; Section 23-57. – Use of signals – Turning; specifically requiring other traffic be affected as part of the probable cause for a traffic stop for improper use of signals, and bringing this section into compliance with state law; repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW:

SECTION I. That Chapter 23, Traffic, Article II, Operation of vehicles, generally; Section 23-57. – Use of signals – Turning, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 23-57. – Use of Signals

- (a) No person shall turn a vehicle from a direct course or move right or left upon a roadway, without giving an appropriate signal of intention during and not less than the last 100 feet before the turning movement, in the event any other traffic may be affected by such movement.
- (b) The signal of an intention to turn may be given by means of either a signal lamp or by the hand and arm of the driver, in which case such hand and arm signal shall be in accordance with State law.

SECTION II. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
