## Rose Specification Variance Suggestions

Raw manures should never be used. *Raw manure is likely to burn the roots of the plants and it will contain 5% to 25% viable weed seed depending on many factors.*

I personally recommend Back to Nature manure and cotton burr compost (BTN). *It is composted and 99% free of weed seed and the ph of this product meets the rose bushes nutritional requirements. BTN also improves the friability of the soil for the correct air to moisture level. It also provides a great environment for naturally occurring microbes to grow.*

6 inches of any manure blended into the top 12 inches of soil will most assuredly kill everything planted in it for months to come. *I recommend 2 inches of Back to Nature blended with the top 12 inches of soil.*

Except for 2.1.1, which I have already addressed the rest of the process is in line with good rose cultural practices.
