

**RESOLUTION NO. 1007**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GENERAL WARRANTY DEED, PERPETUAL UTILITY EASEMENT, AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR PARCEL 12, WHICH CONSISTS OF 0.015 ACRES OF PERMANENT RIGHT-OF-WAY AND 0.014 ACRES OF PERPETUAL UTILITY EASEMENT AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET WIDENING, ELGIN TO EL PASO, IN LOT 7, BLOCK 2, LEMON ADDITON, TULSA COUNTY, FROM JOHN P. BLACK AND AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6000.00 TO JOHN P. BLACK FOR THE 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET WIDENING, ELGIN TO EL PASO PROJECT (PROJECT NO. ST1210)**

**WHEREAS**, the funding for right-of-way acquisition for the 9<sup>th</sup> Street Widening, Elgin to El Paso project has been approved in the 2011 and 2014 Streets General Obligation Bond; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Broken Arrow's right-of-way agent has negotiated a payment in the amount of \$6,000.00, to John P. Black, the property owner of parcel 12, which consists of 0.029 acres generally located on the northeast corner of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Wesley Drive; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA, THAT:**

1. The City of Broken Arrow accept the General Warranty Deed, Perpetual Utility Easement, and Temporary Construction Easement for parcel 12 from John P Black and authorize payment to John P Black in the amount of \$6000.00.
