## ORDINANCE NO. 3490 - Corrected

An ordinance amending Chapter 16, Offenses-MISCELLANEOUS, Article III, Offenses Against Property, Section 16-56, Petit Larceny, amending the definition of Petit Larceny to be the taking of personal property of a value not to exceed \$1,000, amending the maximum punishment to be imprisonment of not more than 30 days, of the Broken Arrow Code; repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW:

**SECTION I.** That Chapter 16, Offenses-MISCELLANEOUS, Article III, Offenses Against Property, Section 16-56, Petit Larceny, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-56. - Petit larceny.

- (a) Petit larceny is the taking of personal property of a value not to exceed \$1,000.00 accomplished (1) by fraud or by stealth or by flight; and (2) with intent to deprive another thereof.
- (b) It shall be unlawful and punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment of not more than 30 days or both such fines and imprisonment for any person to commit petit larceny.

**SECTION II.** Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION III.** An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
