A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GENERAL WARRANTY DEED AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR PARCEL 2, WHICH CONSISTS OF 0.42 ACRES OF PERMANENT RIGHT-OF-WAY AND 0.11 ACRES OF TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR FLORENCE STREET IMPROVEMENTS, OLIVE TO ASPEN, IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 14 EAST, TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FROM DAVID BENDEL, PRESIDENT OF SIEGFRIED COMPANIES, INC., THE OWNER, (PROJECT NO. ST1410)
