

The City of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma (hereinafter referred to as "City"), desires to select a firm(s) to provide Grounds Maintenance services. The successful firm(s) will enter into an Bi-Annual agreement through November 15th, 2020. Additional one (1) year term may be granted at the discretion of the City Council.

If you or your firm is interested in participating in the solicitation and review process, please submit a copy of your proposal, including a description of your services and fees and return to the City of Broken Arrow Purchasing Division 1700 West Detroit, Broken Arrow Ok. 74012. By 3:30 P.M. April 23rd, 2019. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud starting at 10:30 a.m. local time on April 24th, 2019 in the Broken Arrow Purchasing office, 1700 West Detroit, Broken Arrow, Ok. 74012.

Proposed base pricing for services may be disclosed at a public meeting to receive and file responses of this and other solicitations, and at the Broken Arrow City Council Meeting. Purchases or contractual agreements of this nature require the expenditure of public funds and/or use of public facilities; therefore, it should be noted that all other information provided in your response will be considered proprietary and will not be divulged during the proposal review process. The successful proposer shall understand, however, that portions (potentially all) of their proposal (including any final contracts) will become public record after its acceptance by the City of Broken Arrow City Council.

ABOUT THIS DOCUMENT

It is a request for bid, seeking a service as such; the lowest price proposed will not guarantee an award recommendation. Competitive Sealed bids will be evaluated based upon criteria formulated around the most important features of a service, of which quality, testing, references, availability or capability, may be overriding factors and price may not be determinative in the issuance of a contract or award. The bid evaluation criteria should be viewed as standards which measure how well a vendor's approach meets the desired requirements and need of the City. Those criteria that will be used and considered in evaluation for award are set forth in this document. The City will thoroughly review all bids received. The City will also utilize its best judgment when determining whether to schedule a bid conference, before bids are accepted, or meetings with vendors, after receipt of all bids. The City reserves the right to select, and subsequently recommend for award, the proposed service which best meets its required needs, quality levels, and budget constraints.

The Cities Minimum Insurance requirements are included in this bid. Proof of compliance must be included with your proposal.

Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and materials to provide the specified Grounds Maintenance services as outlined in the scope of service section for the following project area(s). It is not necessary for a contractor to bid on all Grounds Maintenance project areas to be awarded the contract for one or more areas. Bid each project area separately on a per cycle cost. More than one contractor for this project based on what is most advantageous to the City of Broken Arrow.

PROJECT AREAS -.

1. Areas shown in green highlight: Use provided flash drive

Scope of service: Contractor shall provide the following services upon each scheduled maintenance cycle: All litter and debris shall be removed before other services begin. Grounds Maintenance shall include mowing, trimming, edging, removal of excessive clippings and power blowing or sweeping all hard surfaces. Chemical edging may be used with prior approval from the City's project area inspector. Chemical applications must be applied by an Oklahoma licensed Certified Pesticide Applicator or a Service Technician working under the supervision of a Certified Applicator. Service definitions are attached.

The Contractor must take all appropriate measures to ensure the safety of the citizens during each Grounds Maintenance cycle. Contractor must supply a list of all types of equipment that will be used to perform the Grounds Maintenance. All equipment used must maintain deflector guards to reduce the risk of flying debris.

It shall be mandatory that a review of the project area be conducted prior to the beginning of the first maintenance cycle. The successful contractor and the designated City inspector shall attend such a review. The review of the project area will outline which sections, if not all, of the project area will have Grounds Maintenance services provided to it.

The contractor must make all attempts not to damage any plant material. The City reserves the right to liquidate damages that are incurred by the contractors during the maintenance cycle. Tree damages will be liquidated as follows: \$100.00 for slightly damaged trees, which is damage that

may heal; and \$200.00 for badly damaged trees which in the opinion of the Horticulture Section may eventually contribute to the death of the tree. Liquidated damages in the amount prescribed will be paid to the City by the contractor, or deducted from any payments due the contractor, or subject to claim by the City under provisions of public liability, property damage insurance policy in effect.

The contractor will be required to notify the City's designated inspector when services have been completed after each maintenance cycle. The City's designated inspector will check the site before signing off for payment.

The City reserves the right to cancel any scheduled maintenance cycle, without payment, due to inclement weather, scheduled activities or any other unspecified reason. This contract may be cancelled at anytime due to poor service, budget shortfall, or any other unspecified reason.

Anticipated Grounds Maintenance Schedule:

Maintenance of all assigned project areas shall be completed on a 7-day, weekly schedule tentatively beginning in May _____, 2019 through November 15th, 2019. The 7-day cycle will begin on Monday and end on Sunday. Mowing cycles must have a minimum 6-day period between cycles and a maximum of 10 days allowed between cycles.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Definitions:

- 1.) Chemical Trimming: Means the use of herbicide in compliance with the Oklahoma Pesticide Use Act, such as "Roundup" and/or an equal. The herbicide may be applied to sidewalk cracks or other specified areas with prior approval from the City's project area inspector.
- **2.) Designated Inspector:** Means the duly authorized representative of the Director of Streets and Stormwater who shall monitor the contractor's progress within the grounds maintenance project area.
- 3.) Edging: Means the vertical removal of any and all plant material that encroaches over or onto sidewalks, curbs, steps, driveways, or any other hard surface. Edges shall have a minimum vertical depth of 1 inch and minimum width of 1/4".
- **4.)** Inclement Weather: Means weather as determined by the area inspector that causes the soil to be in a condition that will not allow the cutting of grass to be accomplished satisfactorily or without damage to the soil.
- **5.) Maintenance Cycle:** Means each time period in the maintenance schedule for the project area. Each time period is defined by a beginning and ending date, in which all prescribed maintenance services shall be completed.
- 6.) Mowing: Means the removal of no less that 1/3 of the leaf blade each session while maintaining the turf at a height between 1 ½" and 3". Mowing shall be performed in a manner not to scalp the turf. Turf shall be moved once per moving cycle.

- 7.) Scalping: Means any action that results in the mowing of any turf area below the minimum mowing height, down to or below soil level
- 8.) Trash and Litter: Means any debris within the project area such as paper, cans, bottles, bags of trash, limbs 3" or smaller in diameter, rocks, etc., which is not intended to be present as part of the landscape. Inclusive of the entire area including sidewalks, shelters, playgrounds, and parking areas.
- 9.) Trimming: Means the cutting or removal of all plant material immediately adjacent to or under park structures, trees, poles, tables, sighs, fences, landscape beds, etc. Also, includes removal of all plant material from expansion joints and any other cracks in curbs, sidewalks, parking areas and any other hard surface within the project area.
- 10.) Clipping Removal: Means the removal of excessive clipping piles. Clippings may be distributed evenly across the turf by a power blower, but may not be blown into the street, adjacent property, or any other hard surface in the right-of-way.
