An Ordinance closing a portion of right-of-way on property located one- eighth mile south of New Orleans Street (101st Street), one-third mile east of 9th Street (Lynn Lane Road), Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, (Section 25, T18N, R14E); repealing all ordinances to the contrary; and declaring an emergency
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA:
SECTION I. The right-of-way affecting the real estate described as follows:
See "Exhibit A"
is not presently in use, and is hereby closed. Provided that the City reserves the right to reopen this right-of-way in the event it is needed in the future, without the necessity to pay the owner or their successors for the reopening of this utility easement.
$\pmb{\textbf{SECTION II.}}$ Any ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
SECTION III. An emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and therefore this ordinance shall become effective from and after the time of its passage and approval.
