> LYNN LANE WWTP SECONDARY CLARIFIER REHABILIATION RECOMMENDATION OF AWARD

Dear Mr. Hughes:

Submitted for your information and review is the Bid Tabulation for the above-referenced project. There were six bidders with bids ranging from \$3,305,515.00 to \$4,243,930.00 for the total base bid and alternate bid items (additive).

Crossland Heavy Contractors, Inc., submitted the lowest bid, which after discussion with the City has been deemed regular in every respect. The total of all Base Bid Items is \$2,100,840.00 and the total of all Alternate Bid Items (Additive) is \$1,204,675.00 for a total of \$3,305,515.00. The low bid is below the Engineer's Estimate of \$3,995,543.53.

Tetra Tech recommends the contract be awarded to Crossland Heavy Contractors, Inc., for \$3,215,515.00. This is the total of the bid prices for all Base Bid Items, which is \$2,100,840.00, plus the amount bid for Alternate Bid Items #2 thru Alternate Bid Item #16, which is \$1,114,675.00.

After discussing the bid results with the City, Tetra Tech recommends against awarding Alternate Bid Items #1 - New 4th NPW Pump - VFD and Electrical/Controls. Based on the estimated NPW water demand at the plant, Tetra Tech does not foresee a need for the 4th NPW Pump at this time. The current design allows for the space to add a 4th NPW pump in the future should it be needed.
