#### DESCRIPTION

The outfall from the dry detention pond located in the southwest corner of the Reserve at Battle Creek

Subdivision drains into the municipal stormwater system and into pond 2 of Stonewood Crossing pond 2.

The lots in the Reserve at Battle Creek south of W Granger St drain into the lots of Stonewood Crossing I &

Stonewood Crossing II not to the subdivision's detention basin. This fact coupled with the runoff generated from

The properties in Stonewood Crossing draining towards the ponds across flatter slopes causes standing and

stagnant water along some of these lots. In addition, it also erodes certain properties near the pond.

## **BENEFIT**

Improves the overall drainage between the two subdivisions and reduces stagnant and standing water, which can.

Be a health issues as well reduces erosion and sediment transport to the 404 regulated ponds.

## RECOMMENDATION

Installation of storm sewer between the Reserve at Battle Creek and Stonewood Crossing I & II discharging into Stonewood Crossing Pond 2.
