O.S. § 74-85.14 - Federal Laws to Govern: Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, in all cases where federal granted funds are involved, the federal laws, rules and regulations thereto shall govern to the extent necessary to insure the benefit of such funds to the State of Oklahoma.

§27A-2-3-202-A-7- Powers and duties of Department: A. Within its jurisdictional areas of responsibility, the Department, acting through the Executive Director, or persons authorized by law, rule or designated by the Executive Director to perform such acts, shall have the power and duty to: 7. Enter into agreements for, accept, administer and use, disburse and administer grants of money, personnel and property from the federal government or any department or agency thereof, or from any state or state agency, or from any other source, to promote and carry on in this state any program relating to environmental services or pollution control;
