

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1321**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BROKEN ARROW CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATING UP TO SEVEN PARKING SPACES WITHIN THE ROSE DISTRICT LOCATED BETWEEN EAST DALLAS STREET AND EAST BROADWAY AVENUE ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF MAIN STREET TO BE DESIGNATED RESERVED CURBSIDE PICK-UP ONLY**

**WHEREAS**, on March 15, 2020, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma issued Executive Order 2020-07 declaring an emergency caused by the impending threat of COVID-19 to the people of this State and the public's peace, health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 22, 2020, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma's Bounce Back Advisory Group issued the Oklahoma Bounce Back Plan implementing a three passed approach to re-opening Oklahoma's economy, beginning on April 24, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the health crisis has resulted in businesses having to temporarily close, thereby losing sales, profits and potential customers; and

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that the City of Broken Arrow has lost sales and use taxes as a result of the pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rose District is made up of retail and restaurant facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Broken Arrow desires to do all that it can to support the local business community; and

**WHEREAS**, this action is taken to support the financial viability of retail establishments in the Rose District;

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA, THAT:**

1. That up to seven parking spots located within the Rose District, namely from East Dallas Street to East Broadway Avenue on both of the East and West sides of the Main Street shall be reserved for Curbside Pick-Up Only.
2. That the City Manager or his designee shall choose the appropriate parking spots and shall post signs reading "Reserved for Curbside Pick-up Only".
3. That no person shall park in a "Reserved for Curbside Pick-Up Only" designated spot unless that person is picking up their purchase curbside. No person shall park in a "Reserved for Curbside Pick-Up Only" parking spot any longer than reasonably necessary to complete their purchase.
4. That this Resolution shall expire at 11:59 p.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2020.

This Resolution is approved in open meeting by the City Council of the City of Broken Arrow on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020.
