Derek: When the preliminary plat was submitted for the Ninety One development, Comment 8 stated, "Development around the oil wells and tank batteries shall meet all state and local requirements. No conditional final plat shall be submitted until written verification is provided confirming that the proposed development near the oil wells and tank batteries is in compliance with all state and local requirements. It appears that the wells will be closed prior to conditional final plat, however, if not, staff recommends access to active oil wells for maintenance purposes should be through a separate private access easement and not through public residential streets. If the Developer cannot have them closed prior to conditional final plat, the streets may have to be private with specific language in the covenants of the plat that would turn streets over to the City once the wells are closed. Any damage to the streets would be the responsibility of the Developer and/or homeowners association with repairs occurring before acceptance of the streets by the City." It has been documented that oil wells were located on the property associated with Phase 4. We are proceeding with reviewing the conditional final plat that was submitted, but before we place this plat on a Planning Commission agenda, the written verification information requested with Comment 8 needs to be provided.
