After living in this area for over 10 years, I have noticed a significant lack of infrastructure to support an additional residential neighborhood and a significant increase in population. These include a lack of sewer access, flooding of roadways and creeks, and intermittently

maintained streets. I would like to ask the commission what plans are being made to reduce the environmental impact on 60+ acres of wooded area, creeks and floodplains? Also, will there be sewer access, and if so, can the surrounding areas with no access expect to be added to this sewer system? Having traversed much of the area where this development is planned, I would like to add that this land does not appear suitable for residences given the creek system that runs through it. Altering these creeks could lead to more severe and more frequent flooding of homes and roadways under heavy rain. Are there plans to mitigate these issues?
