

RESOLUTION NO. 1393

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO DEFEND ROBERT MOTLEY IN THE MATTER OF RICHARD EUGENE HUBBARD v. CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, ET AL., CASE NO. 21-CV-159-GKF-JFJ, in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2021 Richard Hubbard filed a lawsuit against Defendants, Robert Motley, Shane Gibson and the City of Broken Arrow, for alleged violations of his civil rights; and

WHEREAS, Officer Robert Motley has complied with the provisions of 11 O.S. § 23-102 and requested that the City of Broken Arrow defend him in this matter; and

WHEREAS, Officer Robert Motley was acting in good faith and in the course of his employment with the City of Broken Arrow; and

WHEREAS, 11 O.S. § 23-101 *et seq.* provides for the defense of such municipal employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN ARROW, OKLAHOMA, that the City Attorney is hereby directed to appear and defend Officer Robert Motley in the matter of Richard Eugene Hubbard v. COBA, et al. Case No. 21-CV-159-GKF-JFJ, in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Oklahoma.
