On August 18, 2017 the City Council approved submitting an application to the Tulsa County Vision Authority to obtain \$1,500,000 of Vision 2025 surplus funds to a fund design and construction of Streetscape V. This project is one block of streetscape improvements from Detroit to Elgin.

On September 7, 2017 the Tulsa County Vision Authority approved the City's application.
