

At the August 20, 2019, City Council meeting, the Council directed staff to draft and present an ordinance restricting the use of light poles to display donated banners, or any other City owned or controlled banners that promote or celebrate City recognized holidays. The ordinance also prohibits commercial banners or decoration to be displayed on City light poles. The proposed ordinance also provides procedures for the City to process such applications. On September 3, 2019, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 3603, however, the emergency clause was omitted.
