

Tile 50 § 17 provides that in cases where it is deemed impractical to summarily abate any such nuisance, a City or town may bring suit in the District Court in the County in which the nuisance is located by the City adopting a resolution to direct the bringing of the lawsuit in the proper Court for purposes of abating a nuisance.

As noted above, this structure is located at 17639 East 101st Street, Broken Arrow, OK 74011, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said NE/4 of the NE/4, Thence S 01 deg. 26'09" E for 50.00 feet, Thence S 88 deg. 39'30" W for 610.00 feet to the Point of Beginning of said tract of land, Thence S 01 deg. 26'09" E for 280.00 feet, Thence S 88 deg. 39' 30" W for 50.00 feet, Thence N 01 deg. 26'09" W for 280.00 feet, Thence N 88 deg. 39' 30" East for 50.00 feet to the Point of Beginning of said tract of land.

Staff recommends the Council approve the Legal Department file a nuisance abatement action in District Court to abate the nuisance.
