

The public hearing was held as advertised on November 18, 2008. According to the minutes of the meeting, there were two objections/complaints regarding the assessment district, including, city resident Jacquelyn Jacobs, who had questions regarding the amount of the assessment and how it was charged to the citizens. City resident Tamara O'Mara, spoke regarding concerns about a proposed pipe that would be laid through her lot. The pertinent minutes are attached.

On December 2, 2008 Council passed Resolution No. 556 finding that following the public hearing on the improvements the City Council found the protests were insufficient. Resolution No. 556 is also attached. Council's findings regarding the sufficiency of the protests are conclusive and binding.
