

include the City of Bixby, Broken Arrow, Collinsville, Glenpool, Jenks, Owasso, Sand Springs, Sapulpa, Skiatook, Tulsa, Osage County, Tulsa County and the Northeast Oklahoma Enhanced 911 Trust Authority.

It should be noted that the Police Department has been working with INCOG (through this agreement) and AT&T to transition the Broken Arrow Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) from Windstream to AT&T. We expect the transition to occur in early April and this project is a direct result of INCOG's coordination.
