- The Parks and Recreation Department is a small part of this large event. The Broken Arrow Police Department and Fire Department will also be on site. These and other organizations will be offering fun activities for children and families while providing lifesaving information.
- This will be the second year, if approved, for National Kids to Parks Day in Broken Arrow.
