Background:

The Police Department is eligible for an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Formula Grant in the amount of \$13,123.00. The funds will be used in the following purpose areas: (1) Conference & Training (2) Equipment/General (3) Overtime.

The proposed conference and training funds will be used for Officer training, equipment funds for needed upgrades to the Police Department's mobile data systems, and overtime funds for targeted patrols.

As part of the application process, the application must be made public and the public must have an opportunity to comment on the proposal. Staff recommends that the City Council conduct the Public Hearing and authorize submission of the grant application.
